# CABLE JUMPER



**Size:** 12 (16)

**NOTE:** figures in brackets () refer to larger size. Where only one figure is given this refers to both sizes.

**Skill Level:** intermediate

## How much yarn:

g 500 (600) of Camel Hair yarn, in cherry red shade no. 5911

**Needles:** Pair of 2.75 mm (no. 12) knitting needles.

Pair of 3.75 mm (no. 9) knitting needles

A spare needle. A double-pointed (Dp) needle

**Sewing needle:** Yarn needle with rounded point

**Other items:** Two stitch holders

## STITCHES

Tubular stitch - Stocking stitch (st st) -Reverse stocking stitch (rev st st) - K3, P3 rib.

CABLE: (worked on 12 sts)

**Row 1(RS):** K12. **Row 2:** P12. **Row 3:** K12. **Row 4:** P12. **Row 5:** K6, 6 Right crossed stitches (= place next 3 sts onto Dp needle, on backside, K next 3 sts, K3 from Dp needle). **Row 6:** P12. **Row 7:** K3, 6 Right crossed stitches, K3. **Row 8:** P12. **Row 9:** 6 Right crossed stitches, K6. **Row 10:** P12. **Rows 11, 13, 15 and 17:** K12. **Rows 12, 14, 16 and 18:** P12. Rep Rows 1- 18 throughout.

## TENSION

27 sts and 36 rows measure 10 cm square over patt with 3.75 mm (no. 9) needles.

## INSTRUCTIONS

**Back:** with 2.75 mm (no. 12) needles cast on 129 (135) sts. Work 4 rows in tubular st and cont to work in K3, P3 rib until border measures 11 cm from beg, decreasing 9 (3) sts evenly on last row. There are 120 (132) sts. Change to 3.75 mm (no. 9) needles. Then work as follows: 12 (0) sts in st st, \* 2 sts in rev st st, 2 sts in st st, 2 sts in rev st st, 12 sts cable; rep from \* 4 (6) more times, 2 sts in rev st st, 2 sts in st st, 2 sts in rev st st, 12 (0) sts in st st. When work measures 32 (36) cm from border, shape armholes. Cast off 5 (4) sts at beg of next 2 rows: 110 (124) remain. **Next row** - Double decs row (RS): K3, slip next 2 sts onto dp needle and hold to back of work, then K tog next st on needle with the corresponding first st of dp needle, K tog next st on needle with the corresponding 2nd st of dp needle (4 sts become 2: Right-side double decs), patt to last 7 sts, slip next 2 sts onto dp needle and hold to front of work, then K tog 1st of dp needle with the corresponding next st on needle, K tog 2nd st of dp needle with the corresponding next st on needle (4 sts become 2: Left-side double decs), K3. **Next row (WS):** work in patt. Rep last 2 rows once more. **Next row (RS):** work in patt. **Next row (WS):** work in patt. **Next row (RS):** work a Double decs row. **Next row (WS):** work in patt. Rep last 4 rows twice (3 times) more. 90 (100) sts remain. Cont to work straight in patt. \*\* When work measures 18 (20) cm from armholes, leave all sts on a spare needle.

**Front:** work as Back until to \*\*. When work measures 8 (9) cm from armholes, shape neck. Cast off centre 38 (40) sts and cont separately on each side, dec 2 sts every alternate row on neck edge 3 (4) times, working Left-side double decs on RH (right hand) side and Right-side double decs on LH (left hand) side. When work measures 10 (11) cm from neck shaping, leave on a stitch-holder rem 20 (22) sts on each shoulder.

**Sleeves:** with 2.75 mm (no. 12) needles cast on 72 (78) sts. Work 4 rows in tubular st and cont to work in K3, P3 rib until border measures 13 cm from beg. Change to 3.75 mm (no. 9) needles. Then work as follows: 6 (9) sts in st st, \* 2 sts in rev st st, 2 sts in st st, 2 sts in rev st st, 12 sts cable; rep from \* twice more, 2 sts in rev st st, 2 sts in st st, 2 sts in rev st st, 6 (9) sts in st st. Cont to work as stated, inc 1 st at each end, inside 3 sts, on next RS row and every foll 18 (14) row twice (4 times). Work increased sts in st st. There are 78 (88) sts. When work measures 29 (31) cm from border, shape sleeve top. Cast off 5 (4) sts at beg of next 2 rows: 68 (80) sts remain. **Next row (RS):** work a Double decs row. **Next row (WS):** work in patt. **Next row (RS):** work in patt. **Next row (WS):** work in patt. Rep last 4 rows 12 (14) times more. When work measures 14 (15) cm from sleeve top shaping, cast off rem 16 (20) sts.

**Neckband:** with yarn needle, graft in kitchener st Front-and-Back left shoulder sts. With 3.75 mm (no. 9) needles, starting from right shoulder, pick up and knit 118 (130) sts around Front and Back neck. Starting with a P row, work 13 (15) rows in st st. Cast off all sts loosely.

## FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams, set in sleeves along cast-off edge, then sew side and sleeve seams. Sleeves are tube shaped. Join collar to form a ring: half part will be turned on right side. Place collar seam to correspond left shoulder seam and sew cast-off edge of collar all around neck edge.
